This activity is being conducted in collaboration with AIIMS Bathinda and Larit Foundation (Annexure-II)
IQAC:20/2024/03	QAA follow up To match the quality at the global level, an application for the Quality Assurance Agency (QAA) UK university ranking has been submitted & accepted. The Accreditation Cell of the university is preparing for stage 2 i.e. Scoping of the process.
